Trucks can stage at the MWVIC and return to the road once congestion is reduced in the Metro area.

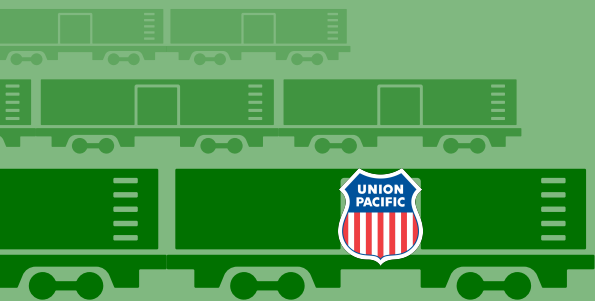
